



## Course Safety Notice

**FOR YOUR OWN SAFETY AND THE SAFETY OF OTHERS, PLEASE BE ADVISED**



**LIGHTNING** : In the event of an electrical storm, a klaxon will be sounded and play should immediately be suspended and golfers should take appropriate action and return to the clubhouse.



**FOG** : If visibility is poor, all golfers are advised to take extra care and must be aware that they enter the course at their own risk



**GREENKEEPING STAFF** : Have priority at all times

Golfers should always alert greens staff nearby or ahead when they are about to make a stroke that might endanger the staff



**THE COURSE, IT'S STEPS and SURFACES** may be slippery when damp or wet. Golfers must ensure they wear appropriate footwear to meet the prevailing conditions. Wherever possible, keep to footpaths and steps. Care should be taken on steep banks and when entering or leaving bunkers



**GOLF BUGGIES** : To ensure the safety of all golf users, buggy drivers and passengers are required to use paths where appropriate or, if no path available, to keep to the edge of the fairways.



**FIRST AID:** Assistance is available in the clubhouse



**DEFIBRILLATOR** : This is housed in the clubhouse and there is also one beside the 7<sup>th</sup> Tee

**ALL ACCIDENTS** must be reported to the Sports Bar or Golf Shop as soon as possible

<b>GOLFERS ARE REMINDED THAT THEY HAVE A DUTY OF CARE FOR THEMSELVES AND ALL OTHER COURSE USERS.</b>	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Players should not play until the players in front are out of range.</li> <li>• Players should ensure that no one is standing close by or in a position to be hit by the club, the ball or any stones, pebbles, twigs or the like when they make a stroke or practice swing.</li> <li>• If a player plays a ball in a direction where there is a danger of hitting someone, they should immediately shout a warning. The traditional word of warning in such situations is "FORE!"</li> <li>• On hearing "Fore!" - Crouch, cover your head with your arms and count to 10.</li> </ul>
<b>PLAYERS ARE REMINDED OF THE NEED TO SHOUT "FORE!" IF YOU CANNOT SEE THE FULL RANGE OF ANY WAYWARD SHOT ONTO ADJACENT FAIRWAYS</b>
