## **LOCAL RULES**

#### 1. OUT OF BOUNDS

Beyond any boundary fence or hedge.

Beyond the fence surrounding the clubhouse and car park. Beyond a line defined by the nearest inside point at ground level in areas identified by white posts or markers. Proceed under Rule 18.2.

### 2. STAKED TREES

All trees that are staked are immovable obstructions (Rule 16.1f). Relief may only be taken from staked trees and not from trees with protective ribbon around the base of the trunk.

## 3. PENALTY AREAS

Lateral penalty areas are identified by red posts and/or lines - all other penalty areas are identified by yellow posts and/or lines. Where lines are present these define the boundary of the lateral penalty area. Proceed under Rule 17.

# 4. PENALTY AREA 18TH HOLE

If a ball is in or it is agreed to be virtually certain that it is in the lateral penalty area, beyond the footbridge (red stakes), a ball MUST be dropped under the penalty of one stroke in the nearest dropping zone. Players in any other part of the lateral penalty area on hole 18 proceed under Rule 17.

### 5. GROUND UNDER REPAIR

Any area marked GUR or surrounded by a white line. These are No Play Zones and players must drop a ball in a relief area based on the nearest point of complete relief outside the GUR line (Rule 16.1).

## 6. PATHS

If a ball lies on an artificially surfaced path, relief may be obtained under Rule 16.1 (abnormal course conditions and integral objects). The same applies if the stance is on or affected by the above.

 FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS are immovable obstructions and relief may be obtained in accordance with the Rule 16.1, but only if it interferes with your stance.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE NOT COVERED BY THE RULES OF GOLF.

Match play - Loss of hole

Stroke play - General penalty (two strokes)

#### **ADVERSE WEATHER POLICY**

If conditions are foggy and it is deemed that players will be unable to follow the flight of the ball or see it land then players must leave the course until visibility improves. In the event of lightning, a klaxon will sound and players must leave the course immediately.
