Dog Stays

- We will provide a cosy bed, snuggly blanket, and some delicious doggy treats to pamper your pooch.
- Our Dog-friendly rooms all have an outdoor terrace and access straight into our grounds for beautiful walks!
- If your furry friends get dirty paws whilst they stay with us, we have a dog washing area to the righthand side of Tykes restaurant entrance.
- There are lots of walks available around Sandburn Hall Hotel through the woodland and into open fields. We can provide a map with the routes highlighted and advice on the length of walk for you to follow.
- We have some dog friendly tables available in Tykes Restaurant. If you would like to go for lunch/dinner here, please pre book for this and make sure to let the Tykes team know you will be bringing your dog.

Dog Policy

- You can bring a maximum of 2 dogs to stay with you, per room
- Dog charges: £15 per dog (*Guide dogs, assistance dogs and hearing dogs are exempt from this charge*)
- **Dogs must not be left unattended in bedrooms at any time and are not allowed on beds or furniture.**
- Owners must clear up all dog waste from the Hotel grounds, paths and trails in the surrounding area.
- **Whilst on site, dogs should always remain on a lead.**
- Any stains or damages must be paid for at the Hotel Managers discretion.
- Owners are asked to control any noise made by their dog to ensure it does not disturb other guests.

Wedding Policy

Wedding and Events Guests kindly please note the following guidelines:

- **We do not allow dogs to stay at the hotel if they are part of a wedding or with a guest attending the wedding.**
- Any arrangements for alternative care are not the responsibility of Sandburn Hall staff.
- If these guidelines are not followed you may be asked to remove your dog from the premises.
- The above applies to guests attending any event at Sandburn Hall.
